- Work safely and understand safe work requirements in the shop
- Fabricate sheet metal fittings from shop drawings using parallel line, radial line and triangulation in proper sequence
- Demonstrate proper notching and labeling of fittings for fabrication
- Proficiency with Ontario Building Code requirements for HVAC systems
- Installation of duct systems, sheet metal fittings, accessories and components to OBC and applicable standards
- Minimum of 5 years work experience in the trade
